A Declaration

The Coalition of the National Movements of Afghanistan comprising:

- (1)Afghanistan National Discourse Movement,**
- (2)National Movement for Peace and Justice,**
- (3)The National Solidarity Movement of Afghanistan,**
- (4)Afghanistan People's Cohesion Council, and**
- (5)Afghanistan's Empathy Process,**

makes this declaration regarding the expulsion of Afghan refugees from neighboring countries

Recently, the government of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan has taken measures to deport Afghan refugees, which in many cases has been in violation of human rights and non-compliance with United Nations conventions.

Our countrymen seek asylum in neighboring countries and in the far corners of the world as a result of the destructive proxy wars launched by world powers in Afghanistan that has in turn resulted in torture, murder, unemployment, and poverty. We expect all countries of the world to treat Afghan refugees, in accordance with the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and international conventions, with dignity and refrain from the violation of their human rights.

The Coalition of National Movements of Afghanistan expresses its gratitude to the neighboring country of Pakistan for hosting millions of Afghan refugees and migrants for half a century, and we requests of the government officials of Pakistan to stop harassing, arresting, and deporting Afghan refugees who are victims of political circumstances. We demand that the expulsion of Afghan refugees be stopped immediately both because of the prevailing circumstance in Afghanistan and because of the advent of the cold winter

season. The declaration of Pakistan's latest announcement is jeopardizing their safety and amounts to playing with their lives.

The Coalition is also asking the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees to enter into a dialogue with the government of Pakistan as soon as possible and prevent the harassment and deportation of Afghan refugees.
